In consultation with The Town Council, The Holt Society has commissioned two Commemorative slates, as illustrated in this leaflet, for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebrations in June this year.

The slates indicate, decade by decade, key events during Her Majesty's reign alongside those in the Town's history.

It is hoped that the slates will be positioned on Fish Hill where it is safe to view them.

The aim is that they should be unveiled during the Town's Jubilee celebrations in June.

The slate has been purchased already, leaving a total of c. £10,000 to be raised for carving, colouring and polishing, as well as delivery and installation.

We have applied for Arts Council Funding but we need to press ahead with our appeal if we are to achieve the required sum by June.

In 2016 The Holt Society raised over £4,000 to purchase the Domesday Slate now positioned in the Methodist Memorial Garden in Albert Street.

Members were asked to contribute and did so with huge generosity and amazing speed.

Teucer, is based at North Farm, Burgh, and is known as one of the UK's leading letter cutters and stone carvers. He is a commission-based artist and specialises in letter carving, headstones, public art and sculpture. Teucer trained at Weymouth College, studying masonry, architectural carving and lettering, before getting a position at the prestigious Richard Kindersley Studio in London for five years. Richard was trained by his father David Kindersley who was apprenticed to Eric Gill. Teucer was given a Crafts Council Development Award in 2001 by The Crafts Council.
