3. Planning Applications.

PF/18/0643 erection of 2 storey rear extension at 10 New Street and second floor rear extension to 12 New Street. No concerns

Proposed addition to silos off the Hempstead Road was discussed. Inquiry from member of the public was acknowledged and it was agreed to keep an eye on the progress of this proposal as it passes through the planning system.

PH explained the requirements for the Local Development Plan in relation to house building in Holt. The report from NNDC has to go through several stages before adoption. PH suggested that the final report should be discussed by the committee next year so that the Society's views could be voiced.

4. Treasurer's Report

GD reported that since 21st. March income had totalled £ 1,475 all of which has come from donations to the 'Escapades in Holt' project. Costs were £ 38.26 for the web hosting charge. The overall balance on 15th. May stood at £ 6,491.01
